Trip to Hackney Museum

Your child will be visiting Hackney Museum as they have been selected to be part of the Hackney Junior Citizenship Scheme (JCS). Last year's event saw over 2000 children from 52 primary, SEN, independent and faith schools benefit from a circuit of varied activities led by different safety organisations. Each of the small-group workshops teaches valuable life-skills to make the children more aware of what they can do to help themselves, and others, make responsible decisions for a healthier, safer lifestyle. This is aimed at 10/11year-olds as they become increasingly independent over the year, both in and out of school.

This is all about your child's transition to greater independence, which will take place throughout the year. A JCS visit links in with different areas of your 'broad and balanced curriculum' and reinforces your OFSTED considerations for enriching the children's social, moral and cultural education in a 'positive climate for learning in which pupils are interested and engaged'.

There will also be someone from Hackney Today who, last year, liaised directly with the schools about their children appearing in this council free-paper. Please indicate below whether or not you consent to your child being photographed.

It is also essential for your child's health and safety that any medication he/she requires is already in school and the correct information has been provided on all forms. We will need to take this medication with us on the day of the trip. If your child does not have the appropriate clothing or medication with them on that day, unfortunately he/she will be unable to attend and will remain in school.
